

2024 High School Volunteer Application Process

- You must have completed the 9th grade and be at least 15 years old by June 1 to participate in this program.
- There will be two (2) two-week sessions. Volunteers will be assigned to one session, with the option of a second session if space permits.
- Volunteers must attend every day of the two-week session to which they are assigned.
- Session dates are June 3 14 and July 8 –19
- Hours are 8:30am 4:00pm, Monday Friday.
- Applications for our 2024 program are due no later than 4:00 P.M. on Friday, April 19th. Only applications that are completed in full will be considered.
- **Recommendation Forms** We will send a link by email to the teacher reference and to the personal reference named on your application. Let them know to expect the email and ask them to return the recommendation form as soon as possible. If we do not receive your recommendations, you will not be invited for an interview. If you are homeschooled and do not have a school association reference other than your parent, you may provide two personal references.
- Interviews are required and will be scheduled AFTER receipt of favorable recommendations.
- All volunteers must attend Orientation. Tentative dates are 5/31 and 7/3, but this is subject to change. Those accepted into the program will be given more information about orientation and instructions for completing additional pre-orientation requirements.
- Please check your email frequently. Messages about interviews, pending deadlines, etc., will be communicated to applicants in this manner. We will not share your email address with anyone. It will only be used for communication between you and our office.
- Reliable transportation is a must. If you must depend on someone else to provide your transportation, discuss it with that person before applying to volunteer.
